The institution is required to submit 2 copies of the Compliance Report, indicating the perturation of deficiencies along with mandatory disclosure and details of faculty recruited for each source in the prescribed format (available at AICTE Website www.aicte.ernet.in) to the concerned Regional Office lateral by 31st August 2008 for consideration of approval beyond the session 2008-09. It may be noted that 51st the institutions are required to submit the Compliance Report along with requisite processing fee by 31st August, every year, irrespective of the period of approval.

The Compliance Report must be accompanied with a processing fee of Rs. 40,000/- in the form of demonstration the favor of Member Secretary, AICTE, payable at New Delhi. In the absence of processing the Compliance Report will not be entertained. Following the Compliance report, the Council would verify the status in respect of rectification of deficiencies through surprise random inspection without any processing the council would verify notice.

The approval is further subject to fulfillment of following general conditions

- That the management shall provide adequate funds for development of land and for providing related infrastructural, instructional and other facilities as per norms and standards laid down as the Council from time to time and for meeting recurring expenditure.
- (a) That the admission shall be made only after adequate infrastructure and all other facilities are provided as per norms and guidelines of the AICTE.
 - (h) That the admissions shall be made in accordance with the regulations notified by the Council form time to time.
 - (c) That the curriculum of the course, the procedure for evaluation/ assessment of students shall be in accordance with the norms prescribed by the AICTE.
 - (d) That the Institution shall not allow closure of the Institution or discontinuation of the course(s) or start any new course(s) or after intake capacity of seats without the price approval of the Council.
 - (a) That no excess admission shall be made by the Institution over and above the approved intake under any circumstances. In case any excess admission is reported to the Council appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the Institution.
 - (f) That the institutions shall not have any collaborative arrangements with any Indian and or Foreign Universities for conduct of technical courses other than those approved by AICTE without obtaining prior approval from AICTE. In case any violation is reported to the Council, appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall be authore against the Institution
 - (g) That the Institution shall not conduct any course(s) in the field oftechnical education in the same premises/ campus and / or in the name of the Institution without propremission/ approval of AICTE. In case any violation is reported to the Council appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the Institution.
- (h) The institution shall not conduct any non-technical course(s) in the same premise? campus under any circumstances. In case any violation is reported to the Council appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the Institution.
- 3 That the institution shall operate only from the approved location, and that the institution shall not open any off campus study centers/ extension centers directly or in collaboration with any other institution/ university/ organization for the purpose of imparting technical education without obtaining prior approval from the AICTE.

- 4 That the full on and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the Competent Authority
 the overall criteria prescribed by the Council from time to time. No capitation fee shall be classified
 from the students/ guardians of students in any form.
- 5 That the accounts of the Institution shall be audited annually by a certified Chartered Account and shall be open for inspection by the Council or any body or persons authorized by it
- 6 That the Director/ Principal and the teaching and other staff shall be selected according; in procedures, qualifications and experience prescribed by the Council from time to time and play scales are as per the norms prescribed by the Council from time to time.
- 7 (a) That the institution shall furnish requisite returns and reports as desired by AICTE at order to ensure proper maintenance of administrative and academic standards.
 - (b) That the technical institution shall publish an information booklet before commencements of the academic year giving details regarding the institution and courses/ programments being conducted and details of infrastructural facilities including faculty etc. in the form as mandatory disclosure. The information booklet may be made available to the stakens of the technical education on cost basis. The mandatory disclosure information shall be put on the Institution Website. The information shall be revised every year with updated information about all aspects of the institution.
 - (c) That it shall be mandatory for the technical institution to maintain a Website providing the prescribed information. The Website information must be continuously updated as a perwhen changes take place.
 - (d) That a compliance report in the prescribed format along with mandatory disclosures on fulfillment of the above conditions, shall be submitted each year by the Institution virtning the time limit prescribed by the Council from time to time i.e. 31st August 2008 for the current year.
 - (e) That if Technical Institution fails to disclose the Information or suppress and/ or misrepresent the information, appropriate action could be initiated including withdrawar of AICTE approval.
- 8 That all the laboratories, workshops etc. shall be equipped as per the syllability of the concerned affiliated University and shall be in operational condition before making admissions.
- 9 That a library shall be established with adequate number of titles, books, journals (both Indian 1. Foreign) etc as per AICTE norms.
- 10 That a computer center with adequate number of terminals, Printers etc. shall be established at per AICTE norms.
- 11 AICTE may carry out random inspections round the year for verifying the status of the Institute and to ensure maintenance of norms and standards.
- 12 That the AICTE may also conduct inspections with or without notifying the dates to verify species complaints of miShort-representation, violation of norms and standards, mal-practices etc.
- 13 That the Institution by virtue of the approval given by Council shall not automatically become claimant to any grant-in-aid form the Central or State Government.
